WHY SHOULD I PARTICIPATE IN MISSIONS?

Matthew 28:18-19; Mark 16:15

◆ Jesus said, “**GO**”

Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation. Mark 16:15

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations... Matt. 28:18-19

◆ You Are God’s Answer to Someone’s **PRAYER**

The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. Matthew 9:37-38

◆ It Is A God Ordained **OPPORTUNITY**

Be very careful, then, how you live – not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Ephesians 5:16

◆ It Is A Godly Thing **TO DO**

Like cold water to a weary soul is good news from a distant land. Proverbs 25:25

Love your neighbor as yourself. Romans 13:9

Suppose a brother or sister is without clothes & daily food. If one of you says to him, “Go, I wish you well; keep warm & be fed,” but does nothing about his physical needs, what good is it? James 1:15-16
