

Week of April 12th, 2020 - Discussion Questions for Ohana Groups
Seeing Jesus | "I Am The Way, And The Truth, And The Life" John 14:5-14

Overview

He is Risen! He is Risen Indeed! Jesus is raised from the dead! In the fifth of Jesus' "I Am" sayings in the Gospel of John, Jesus states that he is "the way and the truth and the life." Jesus is the only way to the Father, is in the Father, is going to the Father, and glorifies the Father.

ICEBREAKER

What is your favorite hike/walk on Oahu?

BIBLE: Read John 14:5-14

1. In light of Jesus' resurrection, what does Jesus mean when he states that he himself is "the way," "the truth," and "the life?" What do these three words convey about who Jesus is?
2. Is Christianity merely one viable religion among many? Are there many "paths" that lead to God? What is the significance of Jesus' statement, "no one comes to the Father except through me?"
3. If Jesus is the way, truth, and life, what does that imply in terms of our devotion, worship, and obedience?
4. What is Philip confused about in John 14:8? Identify the different ways Jesus describes his relationship with the Father.

APPLICATION

Why do you believe that Jesus the way, truth, and life? 1 Peter 3:15 says, "Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have." How would you respond to the question, "Don't all paths (or religions) lead to God?" How do the "I am" sayings provide clarity regarding the exclusivity of salvation found in Christ? How would you respond to the question, "Why do Christians get so excited about Easter?" In light of Jesus' sacrifice and resurrection, what is your reason of hope? Prepare an answer that outlines your testimony with applicable Scripture passages to be shared with somebody this Easter season.

PRAYER

1. Pray that the message of Jesus' resurrection resounds across the islands, our nation, and the world.
2. Pray that families and homes be filled with thanksgiving, joy and praise, in light of Jesus wonderful acts of salvation!
