

Ohana Group Questions/Notes

Overview: Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ will be saved! Are you saved? If so, PRAISE GOD! He wants an intimate relationship with you, and if He is your first priority, you will be beautifully sent to bring, declare, share, proclaim, and announce this good news with everyone you know.

Icebreaker: What is your favorite food or restaurant? Describe it in a way that makes the rest of the group want to eat it or go there. Within your group, who has the best “Yelp” review?

Bible: Read Romans 10:9-15 & Isaiah 52:7

Questions / Application Questions:

1. Life is sometimes very hard. What are some current challenges in your life or in others' lives? (ex. COVID 19)
2. How are people's feet “beautiful” according to these verses? Why does scripture refer to “feet”? (Isaiah 52:7; Romans 10:15)
3. How is Romans 10:9-10 personally significant for you?
4. When do you need regular reminders of who Christ is to you? What is the best way(s) to be reminded?
5. Explain this concept: “The Urgency of the Gospel”. How should it prompt us to share Christ with those who don't know Him yet? What more do you need to do?
6. There are “five ways God sends us out” found in Isaiah 52:7. In what way is God sending you to bring, declare, share, proclaim, and announce the good news?

Prayer

1. Praise God for who Jesus is to you personally.
2. Pray through “A Gospel Prayer” by J.D. Greear

“In Christ, there is nothing I can do that would make You love me more, and nothing I have done that makes You love me less. Your presence and approval are all I need for everlasting joy. As You have been to me, so I will be to others. As I pray, I'll measure Your compassion by the cross and Your power by the resurrection.”

3. Pray for specific people you know to come to know Jesus as their Savior and Lord.
