

Week of October 25th, 2020 - Discussion Questions for Ohana Groups
Spirit's Abiding Victory I Romans 8:31-39

Overview

God is for you and nothing can separate you from the love of Jesus. God is tirelessly working on your behalf to accomplish His purposes and showers His love upon you. You are a winner and God will see you till the end!

OHANA TIME!

Icebreaker: Is there somebody in your family that currently serves or have served in the military?

Ohana Time! (this is an opportunity to be creative and to try out new things as an Ohana Group! Feel free to include children): Play a short game of charades. Try to use words/actions that relate to the idea of "conquering" or "overcoming."

BIBLE: Read Romans 8:31-39

1. What words or phrases stand out to you?
2. Have you ever been separated with a loved one? What did it feel like?
3. How does last week's passage (Romans 8:28-30) tie into verses 31-39?
4. In verse 31, in what ways is God "for you?" What does God desire for you?
5. What kind of questions are asked in verses 31-36? What is the resounding answer given in verse 37?
6. What is the closest you have come to feeling the despair and loneliness of being separated from God like Paul describes in verses 35-36?
7. In verse 37, how has God helped you "conquer" life's challenges?
8. Why does Paul give such a long list of "obstacles" in verses 38-39?

APPLICATION

1. Nothing can separate you from the love of God. Make a personal list or family list of 5 "obstacles" that may separate you (or your family) from God and share with your group. How does God's promise give you confidence when confronted with these obstacles?
2. Reflect on Romans 8 as a whole. Share one passage that has made an impact on your life and faith. What have you learned? How have you been challenged?

PRAYER

1. Pray against all forms of obstacles or barriers that may separate you from God.
2. Intercede on behalf of those who feel far or separated from God. Pray that they would be enveloped with the love of Christ.
3. Give glory and praise to God, for He will never forsake you nor leave you.
