

Week of October 11th, 2020 - Discussion Questions for Ohana Groups
Spirit's Intercession I Romans 8:26-27

Overview

Have you ever struggled with prayer? Do you seek a vibrant prayer life? In our weakness, the Holy Spirit helps us when we pray and intercedes on our behalf!

OHANA TIME!

Icebreaker: When did you need help to do something recently? Was somebody able to help you?

Ohana Time! (this is an opportunity to be creative and to try out new things as an Ohana Group! Feel free to include children): You are not alone because the Holy Spirit is your intercessor! Give somebody an activity that is difficult to do alone (ex. walking through an obstacle course blindfolded, lifting up a large rock). Then have somebody come alongside and help and complete the activity together.

BIBLE: Read Romans 8:26-27

1. What words or phrases stand out to you in this passage?
2. In light of our weakness (verse 26), what are some ways you need help from the Holy Spirit?
3. What does the Holy Spirit do for us when we do not know how to pray?
4. You are not alone when you pray because the Spirit groans with us. How does this make you feel?
5. What can you do when you do not know how to pray or what to pray for?
6. What place does "groaning" have when you pray?
7. Share testimony of a time when you did not know what to pray and the Holy Spirit helped and comforted you.

APPLICATION

1. Today is an opportunity to grow in your prayer life! What have you never prayed for? (ex. government, world mission) Whom have you never prayed for? (ex. your employer, neighbors) What areas of prayer challenges you? (ex. Praying in a public or group setting, praying for forgiveness, consistency in prayer) What tangible steps of faith can you take as you seek to pray?
2. Visit the virtual prayer room at www.kalihiunion.org and pray through the 5 categories of prayer together as an Ohana Group.

PRAYER

1. Pray that God will help you grow to have a vibrant prayer life.
2. Thank God that He transforms your weakness into strength.
3. Spend some time listening to God together as an Ohana Group.
