Spirit's Work of Glorification I Romans 8:28-30

Overview

OHANA TIME!

Icebreaker: Do you tend to see the glass half full or half empty?

BIBLE: Read Romans 8:28-30

1. God has a plan for your life! What confidence does verse 28 give you about events that occur in your life?
2. Distinguish the difference between what you think is "good," in comparison to what God deems "good."
3. What are the two "conditions" for God to work all things for good in verse 28?
4. In verses 29-30, what five verbs describe what God has already planned for you? Describe the sequence (or "chain") of God's purpose for believers. Which of these words speak to you most? Where do you see yourself in this sequence?
5. How is God transforming you into the likeness of Jesus? What areas of faith have you been growing in?

APPLICATION

1. What is God's plan for your life? Draw a timeline of your life and share with your group. How has God called, saved, molded, and challenged you throughout the years? What is in store for you in the future?

PRAYER

1. We can be utterly confident that God will complete His work by bringing us to glory! Give glory to God for His faithfulness and goodness in our lives.
