

Week of November 22nd, 2020 - Discussion Questions for Ohana Groups
Eyes on Jesus: Thankful for Unshakable Kingdom | Hebrews 12:22-28

Overview

Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good. His love endures forever! Jesus has established a kingdom that can never be shaken, a kingdom filled of blessing and goodness. Let us thank God and worship Him with reverence and awe!

OHANA TIME!

Icebreaker: Share one thing you are thankful for regarding each person in your group.

Ohana Time! (this is an opportunity to be creative and to try out new things as an Ohana Group! Feel free to include children): Write thank you cards to those who are thankful and send them out!

BIBLE: Read Hebrews 12:22-28

1. What two mountains are referred to in this passage? What kind of words are used to describe them and what do they each represent?
2. Why is Mount Zion the mountain of joy?
3. Who is the mediator of the new covenant according to Mount Zion? What kind of blessings are available in the new covenant? (see verses 22-24)
4. What kind of warnings are spoken in verses 25-27?
5. In what ways is Jesus' kingdom eternal and unshakable?
6. How has Jesus blessed your life and what are some ways you are thankful for Jesus?
7. What is a proper response to God's goodness in verse 28?

APPLICATION

1. Thankfulness is always intertwined with worship. Give thanks to the Lord by singing a worship song together!
2. Brainstorm how you can make Jesus the center of your Thanksgiving celebration this year. (ex. pray before your meal, set a place for Jesus, each share how they are thankful to God)
3. Though gathering for Thanksgiving may be a challenge this year, what are some ways you can celebrate Thanksgiving and share God's goodness together with family, friends, and neighbors? (ex. visit a homebound member)

PRAYER

1. Give prayers of thanksgiving to God for His goodness and graciousness together in your Ohana.
2. What attributes of God are you thankful for? (mercy, goodness, etc.) Thank God for who he is!
