BIBLE: Read Isaiah 59:15-21

1. Observe the context of Isaiah 59:15-21. What kind of descriptions and words of sin and depravation are found in the passage? What is the condition of our world? According to verse 16, how has God's responded to our dire situation?
2. What kind of armor has God put on to accomplish his purposes? (verse 17) In the New Testament, Paul exhorts Christians to wear the armor of God (Ephesians 6:13-17) for what purpose?
3. According to verse 19, how will the Messiah arrive and the people respond to his coming?
4. How has Jesus' coming fulfilled verse 21?

APPLICATION + PRAYER

1. Reflect on God's armor, and what each part represents. Which part of God's armor do you feel is most important to you now? How have you experienced God's protection recently?
2. Pray for God's protection against the devil's schemes and strength by wearing the full armor of God in order to stand your ground and persevere through trial.
