

Week of December 13th, 2020 - Discussion Questions for Ohana Groups
Jesus Revealed: "Set Apart" * Isaiah 61: 1-8

Overview

Jesus is the One who is set apart, there is none other like Him. In Christ we are set apart to be free from sin. When we acknowledge who He is, He then restores, rebuilds and replaces all that is good into our lives. May it be forevermore that we declare that Jesus' favor has come to bless all who surrender themselves daily unto to Him.

BIBLE: Read Isaiah 61: 1-8

1. What stands out for you from this reading? How does that focus you more on the Lord?
2. How many times is the word "instead" used in this passage? What does God replace from bad to good?
3. After you have read Isaiah 61:1-2, turn to Luke 4:17-21 when Jesus speaks this as well. What is the significance of this?

APPLICATION + PRAYER

1. Give thanks to Jesus for setting you free (v. 1)
2. How can you declare the year of the Lord's favor to those around you? (v.2) Pray for friends and family that need Christ.
3. Praise the Lord for the things that He has replaced in your life. Make a list of things that were hardships/struggles and give the contrasting replacement from the Lord. (ex. Instead of despair He gives praise) (v. 3-7) Thank the Lord for His goodness.
4. What does everlasting covenant in Christ mean to you? (v. 8) Pray a prayer with eternity or eternal things in mind.

- What else needs to be set apart in your life? How and when do you plan to give this to Jesus?
