

Week of March 21st, 2021 - Discussion Questions for Ohana Groups (Shortened Break Version)
Ears to Hear "Diligently" (Ten Minas) | Luke 19:11-27

Overview

Immediately before Jesus enters Jerusalem, Jesus shares the Parable of the Ten Minas. God has given to each one of us talents, gifts, and resources to glorify Him and carry out His mission. Unfortunately, not all are prudent nor faithful in the ways they utilize or invest their "Mina." How can you become a faithful steward of God's talents, gifts, and resources?

BIBLE: Read 19:11-27

1. Where does the man of noble birth go? What are his servants to do in his absence? Who do the master and servants represent?
2. What happens to the one mina given to the first servant? The second servant? How does the master reply to them?
3. Why does the master increase their responsibility?
4. How is the third servant's report different from the first two and how does the master respond?
5. According to verse 21, why did the third servant hide his one mina?
6. What would you have done if you were one of the servants given one mina? (one mina equals approximately 4 month's wage)

APPLICATION

Jesus will one day return and ask us to give an account of your "one mina." What talents, gifts, and resources do you think Jesus has left with you? How do you feel about the way you have invested them? Are you more like the first two servants, or the third? How can you be more prudent in the way you invest and utilize your gifts?

PRAYER

1. Pray for wisdom and discernment in the ways you utilize and invest the talents, gifts, and resources God has given you.
2. Pray for God to multiply your "one mina" and give you greater responsibility to carry out His mission.
