Week of April 4, 2021, Easter Sunday Discussion Questions for Ohana Groups (Shortened Break Version) Testimony at an Empty Tomb 1 Luke 24:1-12

Overview

He is Risen! He is Risen Indeed! Jesus is raised from the dead!

BIBLE: Read Luke 24:1-12

- 1. Who were the women who arrived at the tomb? Given what these women experienced in the last few days (23:26-49, 55), what do you think they felt as they went to the tomb?
- 2. What happened when they arrived at the tomb?
- 3. What did the two angels say to the women? What did the women "remember?"
- 4. When the disciples initially learned that the tomb was empty, what do you think crossed their minds?

APPLICATION

- 1. Why is the Easter story important to you? What difference does Jesus' resurrection make to you? When did the full meaning of the resurrection "dawn" on you?
- 2. Which do you believe more: a) What you see? b) What you hear? c) What you want? Are there areas of doubt in your faith that you have experienced recently?
- 3. How would you explain the importance of Jesus' resurrection to a non-Christian? Consider using the 12 Easter Drive-Thru items that have been shared during the services the past few weeks.
- 4. Looking back to Passion Week and Easter, what surprised you the most or made the greatest impact on you regarding the Easter story this year?

PRAYER

- 1. Pray that the message of Jesus' resurrection resounds across the islands, our nation, and the world.
- 2. Pray for those who do not know Jesus (your neighbors, friends, family).
