Week of June 6th, 2021 - Discussion Questions for Ohana Groups "Who is, who was, and who is to come" | Revelation 1:1-8

Overview

God reveals His divine truth to us through the book of Revelation. He is the Alpha and Omega, He is coming again, He is almighty and victorious! May you be blessed as the Lord makes known to you amazing certainties through which you will bring Him even more honor and glory. May you be blessed to worship Him.

OHANA TIME!

Icebreaker: #1 – Jesus is known as the Alpha and Omega (Rev. 1:8) In one minute, name as many other names of Jesus that you know. Go! (Who in your group had the most names?)

Ohana Time! (This is an opportunity to be creative and to try out new things as an Ohana Group! Feel free to include children.): Draw a sketch or picture based on this passage and share with your group or family.

BIBLE: Read Revelation 1:1-8

- 1. What patterns of three do you see in this passage? Which stand out for you and why? Ex. God is the one a.) who is, b.) who was, and c.) who is to come.
- 2. What does the phrase "the revelation from Jesus Christ" (v. 1) mean to you? What has been revealed?
- 3. The description of the Lord being "the one who is, who was and who is to come" is mentioned twice in this passage (v. 4 & v.8). Give examples of how He fulfills this idea.
- 4. What does being "made to be a kingdom and priest to serve God" (v. 6) look like in our modern day?
- 5. How will everyone see Jesus when He comes back again (v. 7)?

APPLICATION

- 1. God's Word is a blessing to us all. How have you been improving or how do you want to be better at reading, hearing and taking to heart the Word of God? (v. 3)
- 2. If you believe that Jesus has freed us from our sins by His blood (v. 6), what are you doing so that others can know this too?
- 3. Make three columns and title them: 1.) God, 2.) Jesus, 3.) Holy Spirit. Write down as many attributes and names of who they are in that column. Spend time to reflect and contemplate on God's identity.
- 4. Is the Lord the Alpha and Omega of your life? Honor Him who is sovereign over the beginning and the end of all that is in your life.

PRAYER

- 1. Pray that you (and those in your Ohana group) will be better at reading, hearing, understanding and living out God's Word. (Nudge, nudge.... it's never too late to join a Sunday School class!)
- 2. Pray that you will go deeper in your understanding of the Trinity's unique attributes and qualities. As you pray through the descriptions, may this lead you to loving Him all the more.
