

Week of June 13th 2021 - Discussion Questions for Ohana Groups
True Worship | Revelation 7:9-17

Overview

John witnesses a magnificent vision of a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language - all worshipping Jesus, the Lamb of God enthroned as King. Revelation is rich with worship, unveiling the glory of holy, heavenly worship.

OHANA TIME!

Icebreaker: What is one of your favorite worship songs/hymns?

Ohana Time! (this is an opportunity to be creative and to try out new things as an Ohana Group! Feel free to include children): Plan a worship service! What would you include?

BIBLE: Read Revelation 7:9-17

1. Identify all the people/creatures in this passage. What are they doing? Where are they standing?
2. What is the meaning of the white robes and the palm branches in verse 9?
3. What is the importance of worshipping together as the people of God? What blessings do you receive when you worship with others?
4. In what ways does "salvation" belong to our God? How has God saved you? What did he save you from?
5. What words are used to ascribe worship to God in verse 12? Which word stands out to you and why?
6. According to verses 15-17, what will heaven be like? How are the "saints" serving the Lord?

APPLICATION

1. In your experience, what hinders or interferes with worship? Have you experienced worship "droughts?" How has God renewed your heart for worship?
2. Revelation is the ultimate model of holy, true worship. How will you incorporate this glimpse of heavenly worship into your earthly walk?
3. How is worship often "put in a box" (limited to a certain place or time)? What steps can you take this week to grow in your worship in adoration or action?
4. Worship together as an Ohana Group!

PRAYER

1. Pray words of praise to the Lamb of God who sits enthroned in heaven!
2. If you are experiencing a worship "drought," ask God to renew your heart for worship and to restore the joy of God's salvation.
3. Pray that your days will be filled with unceasing worship.
