Q: What is Church Center?

A way to register for classes, Ohana Groups, and other events. Once you are registered, you can access any resources (handouts) related to the specific class. It is a tool to help leaders/teachers stay in contact with their group.

Q: Is it secure & private?

Yes. You will create an account and log in to access.

The public can see what classes and Ohana Groups are being offered. However, only members registered for a particular class will be able to access the class information.

For example, if you are registered for Sunday School Class A, you will see other classmates and access any handouts, etc. However, you will not be able to see details for any other class you are not registered for.

Q: How do I access Church Center?

You can access either on your computer or smartphone.

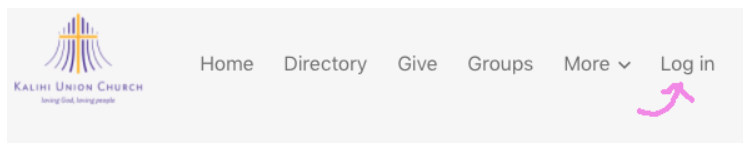
On computer go to: kalihiunion.churchcenter.com/

Or download the app on your cell phone.

Q: How do I create an account?

You'll need a first name, last name & email address, plus optional cell phone. An email address is important because Church Center is a communication tool.

When you arrive at Church Center, click on "**Log In.**" You will be prompted to enter your cell phone. Or, you can click on the option to use email instead.

When creating an account, you will be asked to verify your email & cell phone. A code will be sent to each, and in turn, you'll enter the code into the app or website. This keeps your account secure.

Q: Once I've created an account, how do I log in?

Just enter either your cell phone or email address. No password is needed since a verification code will be sent to you.

Q: What else is Church Center used for?

Online directory. A printed directory can quickly become outdated whenever anyone changes their contact info. The benefit of an online directory is it can easily updated anytime. Each person can control whether or not they want to be listed.

The online directory is private. Besides logging in, you also need to be granted permission to view. The online directory is only for members and regular attendees.

Giving/Tithe via Church Center is not currently setup Please use the website Giving page: www.kalihiunion.org/giving. At some point in the future, this will be integrated.

Q: I'm a member. How do I get access to the online directory?

We will be rolling out the online directory soon. If you have already have been listed in the printed version, you will receive an invitation to subscribe. Please note that the online directory has a separate level of access. If you log in for a class, you will not necessarily be able to view the directory.

Q: Is giving online safe & secure?

Yes, KUC uses a secure platform that is built for merchants. Meaning it's not something homespun that we have built ourselves. We have been accepting online giving and tuition for Preschool and Summer Fun for a few years now.
