# Ohana Group Discussion Questions "Rejoice Like Jesus in Humility!" | Philippians 2:1-11 (Advent Sunday: PEACE)

Week of December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021

#### OVERVIEW

Christmas is a celebration of the coming of Jesus Christ, who being in the very nature God, made himself nothing and took the form of a humble servant. Jesus is our example of true humble service and love.

## BIBLE: PHILIPPIANS 2:1-11

- 1. Reading between the lines, what "problem" was Paul addressing among the Philippians believers?
- 2. What does it mean to value someone "better than yourself" and to "look to the interests of others" (v 3)? What does this look like tangibly in everyday life?
- 3. What ways did Jesus show humility in his birth, life, and death?
- 4. What do you think it was like for Jesus to leave heaven and become human? To take on himself all of the sin of mankind?
- 5. In response to Christ's humility, the Father raises and exalts the Son to the highest place. When you show humility towards one another, how does God bestow blessing upon you?
- 6. What are some ways humility is misunderstood? How does humility differ from being a doormat?
- 7. Why is humility so difficult to express? Describe a time in your life when you struggled with humility.

### APPLICATION

- Make a list of all the ways Jesus showed humility throughout his life and ministry (ex. Jesus always sought to serve and help those in need). Identify 2-3 ways you can grow in humility like Christ.
- 2. What is one tangible way you can show Christ-like humility this week? What is one way you can love and serve somebody with humility this week?
