5. If you were Daniel, how would you have responded to King Darius' decree that no one could pray to anyone but him?
6. What happens in the lion's den? Why was Daniel spared?
7. Are there examples in Scripture of people standing fast in their faith/worship, even when there is pressure against them not to?
