- 1. Why do you think so many people have a problem with someone having authority over them?
- 2. What has your experience been with authority? Parents, teachers, employees, etc.?
- 3. What are the different areas of authority in our world?
- 4. Out of the "A la carte" options mentioned in the message (Friends and Family; Media and Culture; Substances; Emotions; Hormones; and Experiences), which do you feel have the most influence on how we make choices for our lives?
- 5. How would or does having Jesus and His word as the ultimate authority for life affect you?
- 6. What would happen to marriages if we are obedient to God's design for marriage?
 - a. Marriage is the union of one man and one woman.
 - b. God has called husbands and wives to put their mates' interests and desires ahead of their own.
 - God has called husbands and wives to be truthful and to have wholesome, upbuilding, grace-filled communication.
 - d. God has called husbands and wives not to divorce without biblical grounds.
