BIBLE: READ JOHN 1:1-2; 14 & MARK 1:14-18

QUESTIONS TO DISCUSS

1. What is the significance of the phrase “In the Beginning.”? (John 1:1)
2. Who is the Word? What makes the Word awesome? (John 1)
3. How have we seen the glory of Christ? (John 1:14)
4. What does it take for a person to “Repent” and “Believe” (Mark 1:15)
5. What is the significance of Peter and Andrew immediately dropping their nets to follow Jesus? (Mark 1:18). Have you ever done something “immediately” for Jesus?

APPLICATION

1. Memorize the five finger points A.) Jesus came from heaven to teach us the Kingdom of God. B.) The Cross – Christ Removes Our Sin and Shame. C.) He rose again, giving victory over Satan, sin, and death. D.) He ascended to Heaven where He now rules and prays for us. JESUS is LORD! E.) He’s coming back to judge the world and bring eternal justice.
2. After understanding and/or memorizing this Gospel presentation, pray each point in your life. What can you do to solidify this better in your life today?
3. We live in a hurting, broken, and divided world that needs the one answer to all solutions, the G.O.A.T. Himself: Jesus. Pray about how you can share the Gospel with someone who really needs to hear it.
